Habitat for Humanity/7 Rivers Maine creates successful homeownership opportunities for families with limited incomes by building sustainable housing and repairing and weatherizing existing homes.

Our Habitat affiliate has been helping southern midcoast families for over 30 years. In addition to building new homes, we improve living conditions for many more people each year by helping existing homeowners with:

Basic Weatherizing

Buttoning up your home can help prevent heat loss, reduce heating expenses, and make you feel more comfortable. Installing

weather stripping and door sweeps and blocking leaks around the foundation are some of the ways we help homeowners stay warmer and cut costs.





Critical Home Repairs

Homeowners can have home repair needs that are difficult to address. Critical repairs can be related to deferred maintenance, damage to areas of a home, or materials wearing out over time. Addressing these issues can be an expensive challenge and may be beyond a homeowner's ability. Habitat's volunteer teams can help!





Home Modifications

Habitat and our volunteers are partnering with midcoast communities to help homeowners, including those who are older and disabled, remain in their own homes. Modifications completed for homeowners improve safety, mobility, and accessibility, leading to greater independence. Habitat provides funding for materials, training, tools and basic supplies, liability insurance, and other program support.



Home Repairs and Improvements

Habitat's volunteer team leaders develop a customized plan with each homeowner for priority home repair and modification needs.

Typical tasks include:

Fixing/installing doors/windows Gutter installation or repair Repairing/building new stairs Installing ramps Installing grab bars Installing handrails Improving lighting Changing faucets Changing doorknobs Improvements to flooring Basic weatherizing to keep homes warmer/more efficient Addressing moisture issues





You May Participate if You:

- Own your own home or live in a home owned by someone in your family;
- Live in Lincoln or Sagadahoc County or the towns of Harpswell or Brunswick in Cumberland County;
- Have an annual income that is up to 80% of the Area Median Income for your county.

(Eligibility is based on HUD Income Limits Documentation System. Details provided with application.)
