### NEW HOME CONSTRUCTION



When our partner families take that first step into their new home, all of the stress and anxiety they felt in their previous living situation melts away. Kids get a stable, secure place to play and study. Parents don't stay up at night worrying about how they can afford a decent place to live. Since 1991, we have brought the community together to build 48 new homes, bringing to life the dream of home ownership for our neighbors in need. **Our newest homeowner moved into her brand-new home on Federal Street in Wiscasset last June.**

### CRITICAL HOME REPAIRS

In 2023, Habitat helped nearly 100 homeowners in need of repairs continue living safely, securely, and independently in their homes. The work is done at no cost to the homeowner, preserving their income for other basic needs like food, medication, and healthcare. **Our volunteer teams are growing, and we expect to serve 200 people in 2024.**



### RESTORE

Habitat 7 Rivers Maine has returned to our roots in Bath! We started our organization 33 years ago in Bath, moved to Topsham 10 years ago, and now we are back. The ReStore is located in the Bath Shopping Center and proceeds from the sale of donated items support our affordable housing programs. **We can't wait to see you at our new home base!**
